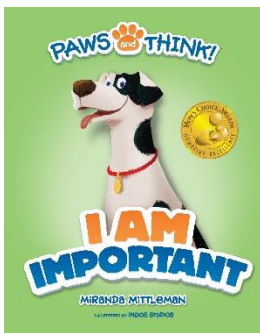
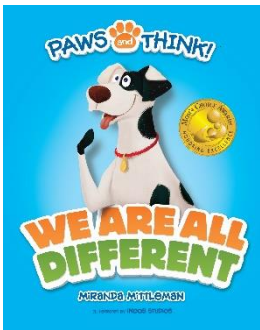

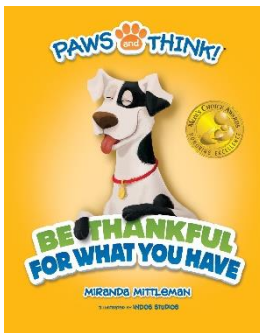

- Who are you important to in your life?



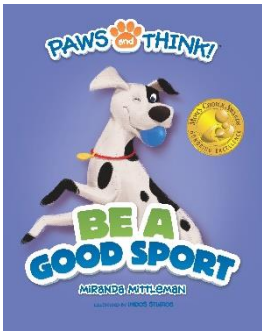
- What does Weaver see when he looks in the mirror?

- What is something special about you that makes you different?



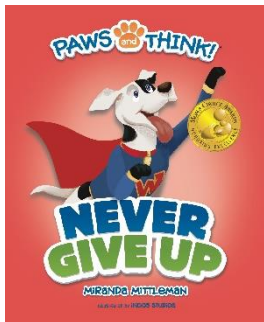
- What does Weaver love about the pet store?
